We are all used to having a PIN or unlock code on our mobile phones, we understand that in order to prevent someone using our devices and accessing personal information, a bit of security is always a good idea ... but what about our desk phone?

Your desk phone sends your **CALLER-ID**, your **PHONE NUMBER** and if there have been unknown expensive long distance calls made from it, it could be **YOUR** responsibility.

A LITTLE BIT OF EXTRA SECURITY

So what options are available to me on the **iPECS** system, to secure my desk phone?

- + **Automatic lock after duration of idle**
Phone will automatically lock if not used after X number of minutes.
- + **Automatic lock after duration from unlock**
Phone will automatically re-lock after X number of minutes from unlocking the phone.
- + **Lock / Unlock button on handset**
Simply press the button, enter PIN and lock/unlock your phone.
- + **Feature and Function keys are disabled** when **PHONE LOCK** is enabled, preventing any possible tampering or changing of individual settings.
- + If forgotten, your system administrator can remove the LOCK status, as well as restore the PIN for you.



SCENARIOS FOR USING PHONE LOCK

- + Phone in public area that could be used by staff as required.
- + IP phone in remote home office, to prevent calls by unauthorised users.
